

WHERE TO EAT AND DRINK AT WATERFRONT CITY

Fourteen bars, restaurants and cafes will open this summer.

SAUSALITO

Type: two-level restaurant/bar overlooking harbour

Upstairs is a fine-dining restaurant and downstairs has a stylish bar area and tapas-style menu.

Run by the successful team of Cath Claringbold and Damian Trytell, the focus is on excellent food and service, and contemporary style.



THE WINE AND CHEESE PROVIDORE

Type: retail store for fine wine, artisan cheeses and produce

Visit the walk-through humidity-controlled cheese room and special cheddar maturation area. Buy a rare, fine wine, or enjoy a casual lunch and coffee.

This store, next to the main piazza, is the latest venture by Damian Trytell and Cath Claringbold.

FLYING FISH

Type: takeaway outlet and market

Linked to the Fish Seafood Grill and Restaurant, Flying Fish offers takeaway fish and chips and a fresh seafood market.

HOT CHOCOLATE

Type: coffee, chocolate and dessert bar

Boasting a chocolate waterfall and exquisite desserts, Hot Chocolate will be a sweet-tooth's paradise. This eatery is also run by Lou Jovanovski.

COCAMO

Type: Italian restaurant

Two years in the planning, Cocamo is influenced by the cool trends and modern finishes of Milan. It will offer smart Italian cuisine with a wine list to match.

BOCCA BAR

Type: bar

Adjoining Cocamo, Bocca Bar is the perfect intimate setting for a pre-dinner drink or celebratory gathering with friends.

MAMMA WOKS

Type: 120-seat informal dining restaurant

Mamma Woks features outdoor seating with bay views, and a menu of modern Eurasian flavours including fast, wok-tossed dishes.

Orders are placed at the counter and delivered to the table by staff.

KOBE JONES

Type: Japanese restaurant with Californian influence

Established in California, Kobe Jones offers creative Japanese cuisine with an international drinks menu.

BEACHCLUB

Type: 450-seat modern Australian restaurant and bar with a Euro-Asian twist.

Sydneysider Ken Suzuki has brought the beach to Waterfront City. Already popular in Hong Kong, the Beachclub is arriving in perfect time for summer.

JAMES SQUIRE BREWHOUSE

Type: two-storey micro-brewery and bar/bistro

Adopting a maritime and brewing focus, the venue is set to continue the success of its Sydney counterpart.

STARBUCKS

Type: cafe

Offering a range of coffees to drink there or take away.

DAIRY BELL

Type: ice cream takeaway

Located on the boardwalk, Dairy Bell offers takeaway icecream in exotic flavours.

Type: 230-seat Brazilian-style churrasco grill
